Take Washington St. towards downtown Gloucester. Take a right on Centennial Ave. at George's Coffee Shop. After approximately .03 miles, take a right onto Emerson Avenue. Immediately after Lincoln Park Garden Apartments and the Veteran's Center (on your left), take a left into the driveway in front of the concrete retaining wall. Our parking lot is at the end of the driveway on the right. Our entrance is at the top of the hill.
